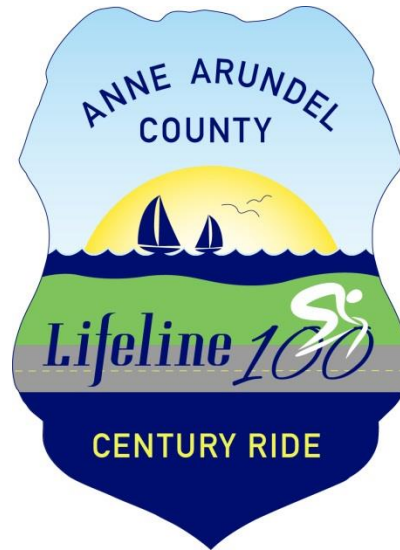


Anne Arundel County Lifeline 100 Century Ride

Overview

The Anne Arundel County Lifeline 100 Century Ride offers a great experience for cyclists of all ages and abilities with 100 and 60 mile routes as well as 30 and 15 mile paved trail options. Our flat, paved trail rides are great for recreational riders and those with special needs. There is a free bike rodeo for kids ages 4-10. These routes wind throughout scenic Anne Arundel County including views of downtown Annapolis, the Severn River, Chesapeake Bay, southern Anne Arundel County, BWI/Marshall airport and more! All proceeds benefit local non-profits.

Anne Arundel Crisis Response

Mission:

The mission of the Anne Arundel County Mental Health Agency, Inc. (AACMHA) is to provide leadership and collaboration for planning, monitoring, and managing of a comprehensive continuum of mental health care to eligible residents of all ages.

Overview:

The Crisis Response System known as the "Community Warmline" is a service that provides Anne Arundel County Residents in crisis with supportive assistance and linkages to resources within the community.

The "Community Warmline" can receive calls 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Non-emergency calls are handled by staff and will provide the caller with information, support and referrals. The Crisis Response System Staff intervene with callers who are experiencing a mental health emergency. Also, the Crisis Response System "Community Warmline" coordinates calls with the police, fire and community agencies that are requesting information on crisis matters.

The Crisis Response System also provides service to the community through Mobile Crisis Teams, Homeless Outreach Services, Urgent Care Clinic, Sexual Assault Clinic, Community Education and Crisis Beds.

Recreation Deeds for Special Needs



Vision: Our vision is to make recreational and leisure opportunities accessible to all Anne Arundel County residents.

Mission: Our mission is to enhance the well being and quality of life of all Anne Arundel County residents by providing recreational opportunities to all citizens including those with challenges or obstacles due to disabilities, financial difficulties or environmental barriers.

We will work toward this mission by fundraising, including seeking grants, promoting recreational opportunities throughout Anne Arundel County, continuing to prioritize accessible programming and creating funding and scholarships.

Recreation Deeds for Special Needs is an inclusive 501(c)(3) organization which recognizes that some citizens may require financial assistance in order to participate in recreational and leisure activities that are offered throughout Anne Arundel County. Thus one of our goals is to assist eligible individuals and families with access to programs by providing reduced fees options.
